

Procedure of removing fat from the abdomen, and preparing it for culturing at UTS

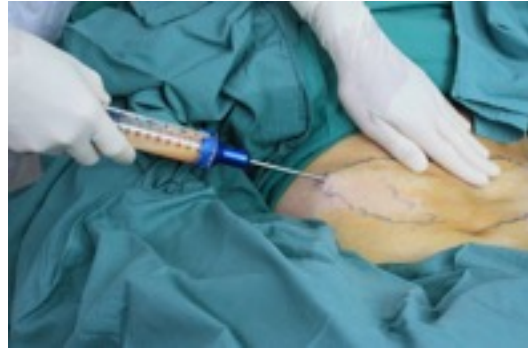
The abdomen is marked, and local anaesthetic is given.



Then there is an infusion of anaesthetic fluid which numbs the area from where the fat is removed.



After waiting 30 minutes for the area to be anaesthetised, the actual mini-liposuction is performed using a 50 ml Toomey's syringe. This process takes about ten minutes.



The fat is then placed into a transportable syringe



And cleansed



And sent to UTS for culturing into neurological stem cells.
